- 1. Should a student wish to be considered for this award they must:
 - a. Submit one letter of support from a faculty member or faculty mentor.
 - b. The nominated student must submit an electronic poster to include the criteria below for award consideration.
- 2. The Chair of the AIHC Scholarship Committee will call for nominations.
- 3. The AIHC scholarship awards subcommittee will review nominations and determine award recipient.
- 4. Nomination by a faculty member or faculty mentor is accepted.
- 5. Submission of one letter of support from faculty member or faculty mentor. Letter must include the following criteria:
 - Letter must include the following criteria.
 - Description of engagement [project, mentorship, clinical or community experience] in interprofessional collaborative practice.
 - Description of outcomes and/or impact on the clinic, classroom and/or community.
 - Evidence of demonstrating interprofessional communication, collaboration and excellence as team member.
- 6. Electronic Poster to be submitted by the nominated student.

Include the following criteria in the electronic poster:

- Description of engagement [project, mentorship, clinical or community experience] in interprofessional collaborative practice.
- Description of outcomes and/or impact on the clinic, classroom and/or community.
- Reflection on lessons learned about interprofessional collaborative practice.

• Description of how experience will impact your future practice.
